On May 11th, the DL Chamber hosted our annual meeting and enjoyed breakfast at WE Fest—Soo Pass Ranch. We heard updates from Chamber President, Carrie Johnston and Board Chair, Jackie Buboltz shared the strategic plan. We also got to meet a few new faces and network with a room full of DL Chamber Members.

In addition to DL Chamber news and program updates, Carrie shared a few numbers from just a handful of 2022 Chamber activities:
