Earned Sick & Safe Time starts January 1, 2024

Sick and safe time is paid leave employers must provide to employees in Minnesota that can be used for certain reasons, including when an employee is sick, to care for a sick family member or to seek assistance if an employee or their family member has experienced domestic abuse.

An employee is eligible for sick and safe time if they: work at least 80 hours in a year for an employer in Minnesota; and are not an independent contractor. Temporary and part-time employees are eligible for sick and safe time.

In addition to providing their employees with one hour of paid leave for every 30 hours worked, up to at least 48 hours each year, employers are required to: include the total number of earned sick and safe time hours accrued and available for use, as well as the total number of earned sick and safe time hours used, on earnings statements provided to employees at the end of each pay period; provide employees with a notice by Jan. 1, 2024 — or at the start of employment, whichever is later — in English and in an employee's primary language if that is not English, informing them about earned sick and safe time; and include a sick and safe time notice in the employee handbook, if the employer has an employee handbook.
