

Legislative News

Minnpost.com reported on Friday, January 24th, the Minnesota Supreme Court found in favor of the DFLers contention that a quorum to conduct any business in the House is 68 seats. The Court promised a more-detailed decision will follow. What we know at this point, according to the author of the article, is any actions taken by the House are voided and the Republicans cannot convene sessions of the House. Article reference:

While things get sorted out, the Minnesota House Republicans and Democrats have communicated their priorities for this legislative session. Taking information from the Minnesota Legislature website, the "House DFL plans to focus on child care, health care, and housing during this legislative session." The first 10 bills introduced by Republicans include "issues related to fraud reporting in state agencies, implementing fiscal management recommendations, returning some of the projected budget surplus to taxpayers" and others.
